Recap of FIIF activities during 2018

- The first **FIIF member survey** was conducted in February-March.
- FIIF concept **ownership and operational responsibility** were transferred to DIMECC from Teknologiateollisuus r.y. and VTT as of April 1, 2018.
- **New FIIF web pages** were opened in April. Later **partner web pages** were opened for sharing event presentation materials to FIIF members.
- Three open FIIF events were organized:
- "Connectivity" (September 20, 2018 in Helsinki 66 registered participants)
- "loT softw are platforms" (October 19, 2018 in Tampere 32 registered participants)
- "Artificial Intelligence/Machine Learning" (November 22, 2018 in Helsinki 41 registered participants).
- The fourth planned open FIIF event ("Cyber security", December 13, 2018 in Oulu) was cancelled due to lack of registered participants.
- Other FIIF sessions were organized at Advanced Engineering exhibition (May 2018 in Helsinki) and at Alihankintamessut (September 2018 in Tampere).
- Industrial Internet Consortium (IIC) organized its quarterly face-face member meeting in Helsinki during May 21-24, 2018. As DIMECC is a member of IIC, FIIF members were offered two special opportunities to get a peek into IIC's ways of working:
- give a presentation to IIC's Innovation Task Group on May 23, 2018 (Tuxera Oy leveraged this
 opportunity), or
- attend IIC's Public Energy event on May 25, 2018.
- Four issues of FIIF Newsletter were published.
- FIIF Advisory Board had two meetings, one in June and another one in November 2018.

As of December 31, 2018 FIIF had 242 member organizations and 666 names on its mailing list.

Planned FIIF activities for the first half of 2019

During the spring of 2019 we are planning to organize **three general FIIF events**. These events are open and free of charge to employees of all FIIF members. Dates of these events have already been set as well as topics for the first two events (see section "**FIIF events during the spring of 2019**" below).

In addition to these "traditional" FIIF events we are introducing a new event type called "**Focused partner event**". As the name says, these events are organized with a partner who takes care of the event practicalities, like invitations and facilities. For FIIF, the main motivation for participating in focused partner events is to introduce FIIF's network, expertise, and activities to new industries and stakeholders.

FIIF Newsletter will be published four times: in January, February, April, and June. If you have material that you would like to be included in the FIIF Newsletter or otherwise distributed to the FIIF community members, please contact the FIIF Manager for further details (fiif.manager@dimecc.com).

In March, we will run again the **member survey** to collect from the members comments, feedback and ideas for upcoming FIIF events and activities and to ensure that members' needs and expectations are met.

DIMECC will invoice **FIIF's annual service fee for 2019** in March. In the high end, there is a new fee category for "Large Industry Partners". In the low end, we will invoice a nominal annual fee of €150 from "Micro Industry Partners" and "Non-Profit Partners". "Academic Partners" and "Public Sector Partners" (as defined in the table below) are still in the €0 service fee category.

Thursday, January 31, 2019 – Focused Partner Event in Tampere (Kampusklubi, Korkeakoulunkatu 7, Tampere) on "**Smart buildings**". This event is organized with the **6Aika Community**, as part of its "Energiaviisaat kaupungit" ("Energy-savvy cities") -project, in which the participating cities are looking for new solutions to collect, cultivate, and use building-related data (energy usage, occupancy, environment, etc.). These new solutions will be piloted during 2019 and 2020 in various public buildings. The event starts with a **technical seminar** (at 9:00 – 11:30), and in the afternoon there is an **ideation and planning workshop** (at 12:30 – 16:15). Both of these events are conducted in Finnish. Please register by January 24, 2019.

Thursday, March 14, 2019 – Focused Partner Event in Tampere with **TAMK** (Tampere University of Applied Sciences, Kuntokatu 3, Tampere), at TAMK's annual IoT Seminar. This year the seminar's main themes are IoT, 5G, and **Machine Learning**. FIIF will organize a session focusing on Artificial Intelligence/Machine Learning.

Tuesday, June 4, 2019 – Focused Partner Event in Tampere with MPD 2019, preliminary topic "Artificial Intelligence".
