DIMECC's thirteenth annual seminar ("Industrial Data Sharing Day") was organized on November 10, 2020. More than 240 people registered to this full-day online event, which was organized on top of an innovative video conferencing platform called Gather Town (www.gather.town). The platform received positive comments from the participants – and even some wider publicity in the [Insinööri magazine](#) (in Finnish only).

## Finnish Additive Manufacturing Ecosystem launched!

**Finnish Additive Manufacturing Ecosystem (FAME)** is an industrial ecosystem that drives to increase the role of Additive Manufacturing (AM) in Finland and aims to unleash the business potential related to AM capabilities.

FAME will be an open, full-scale and easy-to-access ecosystem, that forms a critical mass on AM knowledge and expertise in Finland. FAME will be a hub for foreign investment, and it aims to build a full service offering of Finnish AM know-how that can be exported.

FAME focuses on **the industrial and civil use and applications of AM**. However, as AM is also a key candidate for industrial co-operation related to Finland's HX project, FAME will operate in close co-operation with the military applications when it comes to the **dual-use of tools, materials, and technologies**. This enables Finnish companies to benefit from opportunities that are opened on the military side.

FAME held its kick-off event on October 30, 2020 and its first management Board meeting on November 16, 2020. More than 20 Finnish companies have already decided to join this ecosystem.

## Business Finland: Sustainable Manufacturing Rebound Campaign for the German market

As part of BF's Sustainable Manufacturing program, Business Finland and KPMG are launching an export campaign for the German market. The campaign focuses on two topics:

- **Supply Chain transparency and control**
- **Smart Factory & IoT**

The main objective of the campaign is to find new business opportunities by targeting potential customers in Europe, with Germany as the primary market. Campaign is designed for **Finnish mid-size manufacturing companies** that have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Finnish companies ("suppliers") are gathered during November-December, potential German companies ("customers") are identified during December-January, and the companies are introduced to each other in January 2021.
