Sneak preview to FIIF events and activities during the fall

Next fall's event calendar is still open, as we have received a record number of suggestions for events and topics. After so many months of online meetings and webinars people and companies seem to be ready for more face-to-face communication and matchmaking. A more detailed event calendar will be presented in the next FIIF New sletter, which will be published in August. Here is, how ever, a summary of w hat we already have on our plates.

In February we organized in co-operation with IBM Oy and the Finnish Softw are and e-Business Association an event on industrial process optimization ("**Bit by bit – improving competitiveness through industrial process optimization**", Feb 13, 2020, Helsinki, Finland). We were planning to organize a similar event for technical people in March, but due to COVID-19 pandemic we decided to postpone it to next fall. Planning and scheduling of this event is still on-going (preliminary date: September-October 2020).

On October 6, 2020 w e w ill organize a **data summit for built environment** w ith 6Aika community as part of their "Energiaviisaat kaupungit" ("Energy-w ise cities") and "Ilmastoviisaat taloyhtiöt" ("Climate-w ise houses") projects.

Another event, which we decided to postpone to next fall, is a hands-on **Digital Business Modelling workshop** with Taival Advisory, i.e. how to identify, plan and execute business digitalization and transformation initiatives. This event was originally planned for April 2020, but now we are planning to organize it in October 2020.

This year the theme of DIMECC's annual seminar is **data sharing** which fits well with FIIF's overall agenda and mission. The seminar will be organized on November 10, 2020 in Tampere, Finland. This event brings together different ecosystems, communities and programs and offers an excellent place for contacts and networking. FIIF will be actively involved in the preparation of this event and we are planning to organize a side event with 6Aika community with a preliminary title of "**Use of Block chain for Managing Data in Built Environment**". There may even be some FIIF-originated presentation(s) as part of the main event flow.

FIIF will continue working together with Kampusklubi and AR/VR Mornings in organizing **AR/VR-related** events and activities at Kampusareena in Tampere. Times and topics will be decided later.

FIIF started its **co-operation KOTEL r.y.** with an event in May, and we will continue that also during the fall. In addition to joint event(s) we will define, how FIIF partners could participate in and benefit from KOTEL's other activities, like expert workgroups and research projects. More information will follow.

Based on positive feedback we plan to continue organizing FIIF Flash events also during the fall of 2020. These events are like "FIIF Netw orking Opportunity" on steroids: short online events with 1-2 presentations from a single company promoting expertise and improving visibility to other FIIF partners. You choose the topic and time, and FIIF takes care of the practicalities. If you want to leverage this opportunity, just let FIIF Manager know and we will schedule an event for you on "first-come-first-served" basis.

PoDoCo spring round: 17 new doctors receive funding

The Post Docs in Companies program (PoDoCo) funded 17 new partnerships betw een doctors and companies in the spring round. The program received 28 collaboration applications. Now a total of 151 PoDoCo grants have been aw arded in the program since 2015.

- We received a good variety of applications in the spring round, which is great, because we can

fund projects from all disciplines. The group of foundations funding PoDoCo has lately grow n and w e are able to support the renew al of companies from the for example the view point of social sciences or educational research, says Dr. Seppo Tikkanen, leader of the PoDoCo program.

For example, Moilo Oy and Jan Nåls got funding for their project "Grow ing Empathy: Facilitating Empathy through Children's Storytelling" and Outotec Oy and Shila Jafari for "Mine-Water as a business case".

DIGINNO's SME Digital Maturity Recommender Tool launched

The **SME Digital Maturity Recommender Tool** was developed by Latvian Information and Communications Technology Association (LIKTA) together with other DIGINNO partners. It is based on the methodology developed in the LIKTA initiative "Gudrā Latvija", the implementation of which was started in 2019. More than 850 companies have already used this tool in Latvia.

This tool enables SMEs to measure their digital maturity across 10 business dimensions. Upon completion, you will receive recommendations about the next steps tow ards digitalization, insights on how to start an internal discussion on digitalization as well as understanding of how your company scores in comparison with others.

This tool is part of the DIGINNO project's **Digitalization toolkit** that brings together best practices and show cases a digitalization roadmap for companies.

Check your company's digitalization level with the tool! It is available in English and in some of the languages of the Baltic Sea Region on this website.

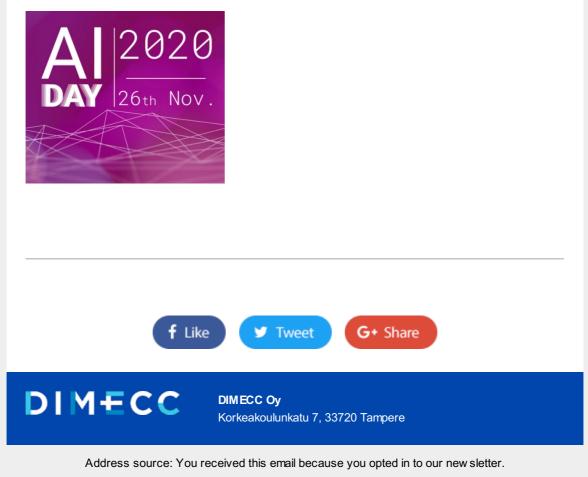






Save the date: FCAI AI Day (November 26, 2020)
