

Get going



- The Commission wants to get the network functioning as soon as possible. Target for contracts with EDIHs September 2022.
- Finland will co-fund the EDIHs with 3.7 million € over the first three years. Combined budget of 4 EDIHs about 12,3 million €. Aiming at co-financing in accordance with the EU timetable. About 321 million € Europe-wide.
- The European network of up to 200 EDIHs is set up for 7 years. Need for this structure is seen also beyond.
- EDIH consortia, the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment, Business Finland and the European Commission are working to get the network going and the production of services underway.

Build impact



We are certainly interested in how the EDIHs will have made a difference for the digitalization and competitiveness of SMEs and other customers by 2030.

But what will be the impact of EDIHs by 2030 in relation to for example:

Research, development and innovation?

• Finland is committed to spend 4 per cents of its GDP on RDI, accelerating renewal in the economy and the society.

Ecosystems and partnerships?

• Different models are being implemented and tested for supporting both research- and business-driven ecosystems, where investments are to make the biggest impact.

• Data economy?

• Data economy may mean a more thorough transformation of firms and the economy than digitalization so far, but what will the data economy look like in 2030?
